<p>Learning agreement (Course choice)</p>	<p>Acceptation of students in a curriculum is subject to approval of the academic supervisor of that curriculum.</p> <p>We advise students to choose courses in the same year of studies to avoid time-table conflicts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - semester 5: 1st semester of the 3rd year (Fall/Autumn) - semester 6: 2nd semester of the 3rd year (Spring) - semester 7: 1st semester of the 4th year (Fall/Autumn) - semester 8: 2nd semester of the 4th year (Spring) - semester 9: 1st semester of the 5th year (Fall/Autumn) <p>For the same reason, students cannot choose courses in various specialties.</p> <p>Students can contact the department coordinator or send a message to incoming@insa-rennes.fr for any assistance.</p> <p>Students should fill in and sign the learning agreement form (can be downloaded in online application), make it signed by their home institution and finally upload it in their online application.</p>

<p>Projects</p>	<p>All departments can supervise projects in their research labs. INSA Rennes offers three possibilities for a full semester. Two students can work on the same project, report and defense.</p> <p>Course codes (for the learning agreement):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - DEI-XXX-10 : project for 10 ECTS (1,5 day per week) - DEI-XXX-15 : project for 15 ECTS (2,5 days per week) - DEI-XXX-24 : project for 24 ECTS (4 days per week) <p><i>(Instead of XXX, please add the academic department acronym, ex : DEI-GMA-10 for a 10 ECTS project in Mechanical Engineering)</i></p> <p>Students choosing the 24 ECTS project should add a minimum of 4 ECTS additional courses (for example French course).</p> <p>In addition to the exchange application process, students should contact the department coordinator to apply for a project. Rates are revised each year)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Housing: 450 euros (housing+meal plan) - Deposit : 450 euros once upon arrival (refundable at the end of the stay if no damage in the room) - Meals: 1 meal at INSA restaurant costs 3,30 euros, 1 fast-food meal costs 5/6 euros - Local transportation: about 25 euros - Student Life National tax-CVEC (for DD students only – payable once for INSA registration: 92 euros) - Additional health, liability insurances: from 5 to 40 euros - Insurance for Accommodation: from 38 to 50 euros per year - Visa validation tax stamp once upon arrival (for non-European students arriving with a long stay visa (VLS-TS): 60 euros
