at the Institute of Electro-Optical Engineering

- 1. The Examination Standards are in accord with the principles and standards for Master's and Doctorate Students as set forth by NTNU (National Taiwan Normal University).
- 2.In order to graduate from IEO (The Institute of Electro-Optical Engineering), the following criteria must be met:
 - a. The course and all of the credits must be completed within a minimum of one year and a maximum of four years.
 - b. Once completed the Master's thesis must be presented orally.
- 3. Before the oral presentation of the Master's thesis can be given, all the credits and subjects necessary to pass the course must first be completed as well as the thesis itself.
- 4. Students of IEO Master's Program must have completed a minimum of 28 credits before they can graduate. Of this total, the compulsory courses for 2 semster's seminar, encompassing 4 credits must be completed, and the other 24 credits of selective courses (for further information about the courses, you can also refer to IEO's website), are outlined below:

The aforementioned courses must also be confirmed by the assigned professor of each student.
